

Wildcountry consultants' Environmental policy

Wildcountry consultants aim to reduce the environmental impact of their expeditions as far as possible by.

- Instilling in all of our participants an understanding and respect for the environment through which they are travelling.
- Equipping the participants through training, with the knowledge of how they can minimise their environmental impact by taking the right foodstuffs (low packaging, minimum cooking times), washing and cleaning with biodegradable soaps and ensuring cleanliness when wild camping.
- Minimising company travel by using instructors who live in (or as close to) the area in which the expedition is taking place, car sharing and by adopting a check pointing policy that does not rely upon car usage but instead utilises our instructors knowledge of the area in which they are working and how this can be achieved through walking and appropriate distance supervision.
- Running wherever possible a paperless office process through the use of Internet file sharing.
- Using, wherever possible green energy sources in the running of our office.
- Recycling (and encouraging the expedition participants to do likewise) as much as possible any waste generated through our expeditions.
- Buying all our equipment and sundries from local suppliers.
